Description of Program

Nationally attended, EarthWalk Institute of Healing Arts is a progressive vocational-tech school teaching the art and science of energy healing to an elite student body. To maintain our high standard of education and student success, we only accept 10 applicants per class.

EarthWalk Institute of Healing Arts offers 560-hour training in the art and science of Energy Healing. This curriculum is presented in a Year 1 and Year 2 format.

In Year 1 each week's classes explore the individual Chakras (based on the works of Judith and Leadbeater), function of each Chakra including anatomy and physiology, color frequencies, the Seven Identities and, in-depth training in energy healing. In addition, students discover and develop their own intuition, high sense perception and learn how to use essential oils and hands-on chakra balancing to assist their patients in their healing process.

Year 2 students will study energy levels of consciousness and energy connections, as well as how to use Acutonics®, Sound Healing, color healing, and other techniques to treat the spine, respiratory system, liver, adrenals, and nervous system. Year 2 students are required to work in a clinical situation as a part of the internship program. At the completion of Year 2 program, graduates becomes certified as an *EarthWalk Energy Healer & Vibrational Medicine Practitioner*, and has the knowledge and tools to bring this powerful healing to all areas of their lives, especially their professional practices.

Student Profile

Students come from various walks of life: people who already are doing alternative healing work, people who are doing more traditional healing work but desire a deeper understanding of the energetic dynamics of healing, and others who are curious about their own healing processes and are seeking alternative modalities. Among EarthWalk students are massage therapists, registered nurses, radiologists, veterinary technicians, teachers, bookkeepers, engineers and artists, as well as full-time parents. We work with each individual to ensure he or she is prepared to be successful in this program. Our program is designed to be compatible with the schedules of students who live at a distance. We have many who travel from other states to attend our classes.

Prerequisites

Year 1 all students must have a high school diploma or GED to enter the program and must be at least 18 years of age. A preadmission interview will be conducted with each applicant. Acceptance to the program requires that the applicant be in good health and demonstrate the ability to comprehend the material and successfully apply training in a professional arena.

Year 2 Admission to Year 2 requires applicants to complete and pass all Year 1 requirements.

Program Calendar

Year 1 program consists of 5 week-long intensives. Each week consists of 40 hours for a total of 200 hours with 30 hours credit given for reports and documented homework sessions. The 5 week intensives will be presented approximately over a 5-6 month period. With self-study assigned between class sessions, you are able to maintain your current professional and personal responsibilities.

Year 2 program consists of 8 week-long intensives. Each week consists of 40 hours for a total of 320 hours with 30 hours credit for Professional Internship. The 8 week intensives will be presented approximately over an 8-9 month period.

There are three class starts per year; winter, spring, and fall. Schedules for new programs are available upon request.

Classroom Facilities

EarthWalk Institute of Healing Arts programs are held at our school facility in Bellevue, WA. This new location is just 2 miles from I 405 and close proximity to Seattle, Kirkland, Redmond and Renton. We offer spacious classrooms that are easily adapted to the multiple needs of table work and hands-on clinics. Maximum class size is 10. Minimum class size is 6.

Tuition and Costs

Tuition

Year 1 is \$5300. A deposit of \$300 is required within two weeks of acceptance to secure your place in the program, balance due 15 days prior to the first day of class. If you select our payment option, a carrying fee of \$350 will be added to the tuition. The first month's payment must be received 15 days prior to the first day of class. Call the school for in-house payment plan information.

Year 2 is \$7200. A deposit of \$300 is required within two weeks of acceptance to secure your place in the program, balance due 15 days prior to the first day of class. If you select our payment option, a carrying fee of \$350 will be added to the tuition. The first month's payment

What are the Career Opportunities?

The opportunities for success in the healing arts professions are better now than ever. Our career program is designed for people who want to take this work into the world and earn their living with it. Program Courses and Hours

Year 1

230 Hours

Energetic Healing: This course helps each student to develop their own felt- sense of energy and how it manifests and processes through the human chakra system. The development of High Sense Perception and intuition is encouraged through hands-on practice and techniques, working with color frequencies, material concepts, and personal exploration via journal exercises.

Aromatherapy: Essential Oils and the Energetic & Physical Bodies In this class student will learn how to identify truly therapeutic grade essential oils. Students will gain skill needed to use safely and effectively during an energy session. After completion of this course, students will be able to describe the physiological and emotional effects of many essential oils, as well as learn how the oils are used to effect change in the physical and energetic systems of the body. This is a highly experiential course, which gives the student an opportunity to work with essentials oils themselves, as well as in a clinical setting.

Ethics: This course is designed to improve the student energy practitioner's awareness and abilities in communicating with their clients and other health professionals. Verbal and non-verbal communication, client interaction, human behavior, boundaries, ethics of touch and listening skills will be covered.

Human Behavior:

- **History of Healing; Medicine, Magic and Healing:** This course identifies and describes multiple cross-cultural influences on perceptions of disease and health. Students will learn to analyze and describe relationships among science, religion and energy healing, and show an interdisciplinary approach to the understanding and application of healing issues.

- **The Seven Identities:**
We will explore our sense of Identity as we expand our mode of consciousness from one chakra to the next. As we explore these identities, we are given the opportunity to know ourselves at a deeper level. To be aware of our life's journey is impacted on a personal level and as a Healer. An intricate part of becoming a healer is to first heal you. Once you are clear about and worked on your own issues you can better support others in their healing journey.

- **Shadow Healing:** This class is basically experiential. The focus will be on self; discovering the shadow side of our human nature; and reclaiming the power behind the shadow.

Anatomy & Physiology:

- **Western-** The objective of this class is to provide students with basic information about the human body from a western point of view and new emerging information about the commutation and energetic systems of cells and tissues. The goal of this is to give students an understanding of our physical beings, to provide a language for interacting with western medical practitioners and to aid students in their ability to effectively run energy into the organs and tissues of the body. Throughout the course students gain a thorough and applicable understanding of all major systems of the body in relation to energy, health and healing.

Clinical Treatment

Medical Record Keeping: Charting is the standard format for documenting treatment sessions in the health care field. This course will teach the student how to chart simply, concisely, and professionally. Upon completion, students will be proficient in all stages of charting and be able to successfully communicate with other health care professionals as well as document their clients' progress.

330 Hours

Treatments: This is for the development of each student's High Sense Perception, felt-sense of energy and how it manifests and processes through the human Auric Field and chakra system. Upon completion of this course students will be able to give Advanced Energy Healing Treatments; demonstrating the use of Advanced Techniques; the structure and function of the Energetic Levels of Consciousness and its physical and energetic connections between human anatomies.

Aromatherapy: Releasing Emotional Patterns with Essential Oils: This class will focus on how to identify negative emotional patterns, and learn how to release these old patterns by using therapeutic grade essential oils. Unhealthy emotional patterns have a negative effect on the quality of life. The students will gain skills to guide clients in identifying old emotional patterns that have a negative effect on their mental, emotional and/or physical health. Once the pattern is recognized, the oils will be used, along with specific points on the body, to shift the patterns and created a new and healthy way to express emotions. This is a powerful way to utilize the natural healing power of essential oils provided for us by mother earth.

Sound Healing:

This course describes the scientific fundamentals of sound. Students will use the specific applications of sound to promote specific healing. Also they will learn to integrate these applications with other forms of energy and the physical body healing. Identify and use sound signatures. Create resonant frequency sounds in order to assist healing. Use toning as a diagnostic tool. Balance and energize chakras with sounds. Use the human voice and instruments to create harmonics.

Acutonics ®: (Tuning Forks)

The course is to provide students a theoretical context for as well as a hand on experience in the modality of Acutonics Sound Healing. This will include the effects of sound on the body, the use of the Ohm forks on meridian and chakra imbalances.

Anatomy & Physiology:

- **Applied Kinesiology (AK):** In this class students will learn: a system for evaluating and correcting bodily functions using muscle testing as its main tool of evaluation.

Introduction to Concepts of Homeopathy:

This course is designed to enable students to become proficient at assessing acute, self-limiting conditions, and prescribe appropriate homeopathic remedies found in the provided kit. Emphasis will be on philosophy, theory and usage of common remedies, as they apply to human injury, infection, contagious diseases.

Shamanic Studies: In this course, students will learn the language of nature - physical, spiritual, and magical - as it speaks to you every day. Students will learn to read and apply what is said: through signs and omens, as they develop a greater reverence and respect for all life, and greater power and control in their own lives.

Student Clinic: Student Clinic is an opportunity for students to provide energy healing sessions to the public under the supervision of an instructor. Student Clinic provides a supportive learning environment, preparing students for the transition from school to professional work as a Certified Energy Healer and Vibrational Medicine Practitioner

Clinic provides a supportive learning environment, preparing students for the transition from school to professional work as a Certified Energy Healer and Vibrational Medicine Practitioner

Student Clinic I is focused on basic energy healing techniques. The students have completed their first term and skills include Chakra cleansing and balancing, charging the auric field color frequencies, and aromatherapy. These techniques will help your overall sense of well being, decrease stress, anxieties, and pain and increase the healing process of injuries or surgeries.

Student Clinic II takes place when students have completed the full program and are ready for graduation. The students have learned and integrated techniques from Chakra Assessment and Reconstruction, specific treatments for Spine, Respiratory, Nerve System, Liver, Adrenals, Sound Healing, Acutonics®, Color Healing, Homoeopathy, Aromatherapy and Applied Kinesiology and can offer a specific treatment for each individual's needs.

Special Interest Courses:

Gathering Your Medicine *To Walk the Mythical Path with Practical Feet*

This 100 hour program is presented in a series of five 3-day training sessions over a period of nine months.

Based upon the ancient symbol of the medicine wheel we will be exploring the four archetypes.

Walking the Path of:

- the Warrior, *Show up and choose to be present*
- the Healer, *Pay attention to what has heart and meaning*
- the Visionary, *Tell the truth without blame or judgment*
- the Teacher, *Be open to outcome, not attached to outcome.*

Just like a mirror can be used to see things not normally visible (e.g. behind us or around a corner), the medicine wheel can be used to help us see or understand things we can't quite see or understand because they are ideas and not physical objects.

When the medicine wheel is used as a mirror by sincere human beings, it shows that within them are hidden many wonderful gifts that are not yet developed.

Native Wisdom

This program will facilitate greater self-awareness, compassion and understanding of yourself and others. By exploring the four universal archetypes you will learn how to bring more of who you are to what you do, to be more effective in both your personal and professional life. You will learn through a variety of methods including lecture, small and large group discussion, demonstrations, and experiential exercises.
